## **BIRDS IN THE PARK**

#### **Dark-Eyed Junco**

Juncos are very hardy winter visitors and are common locally, even on the coldest winter mornings. All juncos flash white outer tail feathers in flight, which is an easy identifier, all have gray heads and dark eye-patches and all are ground-feeders that fly into trees or shrubs when alarmed. You will not see them at perch-feeders, but they are common ground foragers around bird feeders of every kind and around decks and yards cleared of snow where they might find tiny seeds or other morsels of food.

The Dark-eyed Junco is a member of the sparrow family. Strictly North American, it is a collection of sub-species that spreads itself from northern Florida to Labrador and from southern California to far-western Alaska and everywhere in between. There are at least six regional populations and more local variations. In Steamboat Springs, we see several of these sub-species and the photos above show two that are common here and easily distinguished.

The Oregon Junco is a buff-sided bird with brown wings that breeds in coastal areas between southern Alaska and southern California but winters inland in the southwestern states as far north as Northwest Colorado.

The Slate-colored Junco male is dark gray all over but the female, shown here, is less dark. It is the most widely-dispersed junco; it breeds across Canada and Alaska and winters across the USA. It is one of the group of gray juncos that until fairly recent years were loosely referred to as Mexican Juncos. This group also included what are now the Gray-headed, the Red-backed and the White-winged, all of which have small geographic niches.

## THE FIRST TO BLOOM

Snowdrops, also called the flower of hope, are the first flowers to bloom in Sascha's Rock Garden which is located near the Core Trail in the Botanic Park. Snowdrops, whose botanical name is Galanthus, are the sign that winter is over. Surprisingly, as delicate as they look, they are not bothered by snow and frost.

The tiny pearl-like flowers bloom out of an arching

stem, the flowers are honey scented and they are such a welcomed sign among the rocks. The snowdrop's bulb contains an alkaloid used in 70 countries to manage Alzheimer's. The ancient Greeks believed in its powerful mind-altering effect.

This season promises to be exciting, including first up – a new Fairy Garden Village in the Children's Garden! Rams Masonry is in gratis creating stone "islands" that will be the new home for the fairy garden houses. And Kerry Kaster is hard at work with renovations in the Children's Garden where he is transforming the play structure into a steamboat with paddle wheels, smokestacks, and a little library to learn and explore.

We have been cleaning out the former Fairy Garden to provide a new backdrop for Frida Kahlo's Garden, Garden Installation that will be on display June 18 – August 11. Presented by Opera Steamboat, this installation will complement the art exhibit that will be on display at Steamboat Creates. This exhibition is made possible by NEH on the Road, a special initiative of the National Endowment for the Humanities. Frida Kahlo's Garden is adapted from the exhibition, FRIDA KAHLO: ART, GARDEN, LIFE, organized by guest curator Adriana Zavala at The New York Botanical Garden.

Other garden projects include new rock work and adding more varieties of native plants in Dorothy's Garden. The Annuals Garden will be planted on June 9 with the annuals donated from Tagawa Greenhouses and grown in partnership with SOROCO High School FFA.

We are thrilled to add new staff members to our team that have backgrounds and education in horticulture and landscape design. We will also continue our Horticulture Internship program this year with a local high school student from SOROCO's FFA horticulture program.

We are adding even more expertise in the garden with the help of visiting volunteer Ann Frazier who will stay with us for two weeks and help update our plant inventory, recording, and mapping. Ann is renowned horticulturist Panayoti Kelaidis' former assistant at the Denver Botanic Gardens and is traveling to regional gardens throughout the summer to help!

It was a dry, early winter, so there is some damage to shrubs and some of the Alpine plants in the Crevice Garden. A lot of snow in February helped keep things covered and made the snow pack a bit better. We are starting into our season on the dry side. My advice to everyone is to deep water your trees — they will benefit from a long, slow drip at the base several times this summer.
